Registration

You are already successfully registered. In order to start Lp Method you need to do the Lp level test.

Lp Level Test

In order to get you started at the right level of Lp you need to do the Lp level test. In total there are four Lp Level tests. These are:

- **Lp Level Test 1**, which corresponds to an **elementary** level of English
- **Lp Level Test 2**, which corresponds to a **lower-intermediate** level of English
- **Lp Level Test 3**, which corresponds to a **higher-intermediate** level of English
- **Lp Level Test 4**, which corresponds to an **advanced** level of English

First you'll have to do the Lp Level Test 1. Each of the Lp Level Tests contains 25 questions. You'll have the option of seeing your mistakes once you have finished each test. You must get an 80% score before you can pass to the next Level Test. Once your level is determined you can enter Lp. Then you can reach higher levels by doing the exercises and getting 1,000 points or by achieving a scholarship. Start Lp

After doing the Lp Level Test you can enter the programme and actually start playing. You will have access to different language categories. Each category contains different language zones. You first select a category and then a zone. A zone is simply an area of the language like *Prepositions*, *Question Tags*, *Make versus Do*, etc.

Recommended order to play Lp for elementary users

We recommend that elementary users begin playing Lp with the following zones:

1. To Be
2. Do - Does
3. Vocabulary Express
4. Postpositions

The Programme

Before you start playing

You have now selected a zone and you are almost ready to play Lp. Before you start you should read the *objective*, *reminder* and *instructions* for the zone.

- The objective tells you what the goal of the zone is.
- The reminder revises the grammar you need to know in order to do the exercises correctly.
- The instructions tell you how to do the exercise.

The *objective*, *reminder* and *instructions* are available in different languages. click on *Language* in the menu on the left to change it from English to your language.

When you have finished reading the *objective*, *reminder* and *instructions* you must click on *START* and do the following before you can start playing:

- Select the time you think you need to answer the questions
- Select the number of sets you would like to do
- Select the level you would like to play in (remember that you cannot access levels higher than the level you obtained in the Lp Level Test).
- Click on the *START* button.

During the exercise

Once you have clicked on *START* the set will begin. Each set consists of 25 questions and you have to answer them all without interruption. There is no pause option. If you have selected more than one set, you will have some time between the sets to look at your mistakes, and to take a break.

While you're doing the exercise you will be provided with the following information:

- What level you're playing at
- The number of sets you've selected and what set you're doing at that moment
- The time you've selected for the exercise
- The number of mistakes you've made up to that moment.

After answering a question you will immediately see if you've answered *wrong*, *right* or if you have exceeded your time limit (*time up*).

Debriefing

After each set you get a debriefing for that set. On the screen you can see the mistakes you've made (if any). The mistakes marked in red mean that you gave an incorrect answer. The ones marked in orange mean that you didn't answer within the time limit. In order to leave the screen you click on *End Session* which will take to a screen that gives you information about your score or on *Next Set*. To do the next set (if you selected more than one).

Score

When you finish your selected number of sets you get an overview of your score. You will see the number of points you've scored for the session you have just done. At the top of the screen the following statistics will be provided:

- The number of mistakes you've made
- The number of points you've scored in that session
- Your accumulated score

There is a minimum number of questions you must get right in order to score points. If you don't reach that minimum of correct answers you will not score any points for the set. The conditions for scoring are given in the section *Scoring and moving up to higher levels* later on in this manual.

What's next?

After looking at your score, click on *End Session* and the language categories menu will appear again. You can do another set in the same zone or try other language zones in other categories.

Scoring and moving up to higher levels

Each set consists of 25 questions for which you can get a maximum of 25 points. As we mentioned before, there is a minimum percentage of questions that you need to answer correctly in order to score. This percentage depends on your total score. The *no scoring* percentages are as follows:

Your Score	Minimum % of correct answers	Minimum number of correct answers
0 – 199	50%	13
200 – 399	60%	15
400 - 599	70%	18
600 - 799	80%	20
800 - 899	90%	23
900 - 1000	96%	24

There are three ways to get to a higher level:

1. Reach a score of 1,000 points
2. Get a scholarship. You get a scholarship after doing 3 consecutive sets without making any mistakes.
3. You can do the Lp Level Test one more time if you think you have a higher level than the one you are playing in.

Summary of order of use

1. Log on
2. Click on *START LP*
3. Select category and zone (see page 5, for recommended order)
4. Read the objective, reminder and instructions.
5. Click on *START* and then select the time you need, your level, the number of sets you want to do and then click on *START* again.
6. Do the set(s)
7. Check your mistakes (if any)
8. Check your score
9. *End Session* and start again by selecting a zone or check out *My Stats*.

My Account

After logging in, you get to the page where you can start Lp Method. From there you can access your My Account page in the main menu which is a page with all your personal information and information about your account. You can avail of the following possibilities:

1. You can *change your password*
2. You can view your *personal details* and change them
3. You can see what version of Lp you have and the expiry date.
4. You can tell us what you think of Lp by filling in the *Lp Questionnaire*.
5. You can *renew* your user account from this page
6. You can *send us an e-mail* with your questions or comments

My Stats

This is a personal page where you can consult all the statistics of the sets you've done in Lp. You can see your total score for each language zone as well as the complete progression from the moment you began Lp. This includes the number of sets you did, when you did them and how many points you scored.

You can access My Stats from the main menu on the left while you are inside the programme when you are logged on.

Tom Red's Weekly Review is an additional service we offer you to learn and to improve your English. This section is full of interesting tit-bits. There are questions for you to answer from different categories (history, art, geography, etc.), jokes and funny expressions and a lot of other curious things for you to discover.
